



NCAA women's basketball teams will play 10 games in San Juan, Puerto Rico

San Juan, Puerto Rico, November 23, 2021- Ten teams from Division I of women's NCAA basketball will play ten "off conference" games on November 26 and 27, starting at 11:00 in the morning, at the Roberto Clemente Coliseum, in San Juan.

The 2021 San Juan Shootout tournament, which Discover Puerto Rico supports, is open to the public and will feature more than 130 players of the NCAA's highest level. It is estimated that the games and tournament will create an economic impact for Puerto Rico of more than \$500,000.

Sport Tours International produces the event. The teams participating in the San Juan Shootout are Virginia Tech, Missouri State, University of Tennessee at Martin, George Washington University, New Mexico State, Louisiana State, Florida Gulf Coast University, Tennessee Tech, and others.

Liz Kitley, of Virginia Tech, and Kierstan Bell, of Florida Gulf Coast University, are among the players who will participate. Both average 21 points per game. Other great scorers include Ciaja Harbison of St. Louis University and Mariah White of Missouri State. In addition to the practice sessions and games, the teams – including coaches and assistants – will have time off to tour local attractions.
