Across three videos, Luis Clemente, the son of the legendary baseball player, explains why La Parguera, El Yunque, and Aguadilla were special places for him and his family.

The initiative calls for baseball enthusiasts to explore Clemente's deep connection to Puerto Rico and walk in the footsteps of the star player beyond the stadiums and the playing fields. Aguadilla, meanwhile, was the town where Clemente offered his last baseball clinic days before the plane crash that claimed his life in 1972.

In addition to the connection with Clemente, the videos explore successful tourist offerings in the area. The local commerce highlighted in these places includes cafes, surfing shops, hotels, and a natural juice bar.

Discover Puerto Rico is running several initiatives to highlight the destination among sports lovers, including a new section on the Discover Puerto Rico website dedicated exclusively to promoting Puerto Rican baseball.
