OLD SAN JUAN WALKING TOUR WITH RUM TASTING

Explore the allure of the Old City: Culture, History, Rum Tasting and Gastronomy. Join our resident expert of Old San Juan for a walk through the cobblestone streets of the colonial city.

The stroll includes both the historical sites and favorite places of the *sanjuaneros* (bohemian local residents). The walk will be followed by rum tasting in a local restaurant. During the tour we will explore the colonial quarters of San Juan, the capital of Puerto Rico, founded by the Spanish conquistadors in 1521.

This is not only the oldest city in the United States, but one of the two oldest European cities in Latin America. In contrast with the capitals of the neighboring islands, Old San Juan has preserved its historical identity and architectural integrity thanks to the activism of the local cultural luminaries.

See the geopolitical allure of the island through the eyes of Columbus, Queen Elizabeth I, Sir Francis Drake and Sir George Clifford, Spanish kings and American Presidents. Among multiple historical attractions - Fort San Felipe del Morro, Fort San Cristóbal, La Catedral de San Juan Bautista de Puerto Rico and La Fortaleza, the oldest executive mansion still in use in the New World.

Today's urban legends, modern folklore, and a lively discussion of Puerto Rico's ambiguous political status will help you connect past with present and emerge from the tour with a new understanding of this unique Caribbean island and its people.

Puerto Rico is known as rum capital of the world. Bacardi, our best-selling rum, is produced here. Local boutique rum production will be the focus of our rum tasting, with the ultimate goal of discovering your own taste for rum.
